## III. Discussion

WC for students returning from Study Abroad early due to COVID-19: Kerryellen Vroman, GEC, initially contacted Nicky about allowing 96 students who are being forced to return to the US from Italy early due to COVID-19 be allowed to have WC requirement fulfilled and the DC approved allowing WC for these students at their meeting on Mar 11, 2020. Nicky updated the DC that she determined on their behalf that (roughly) 184 students would be allowed to have WC fulfilled, not just the 96 who returned from Italy. Reasons for Nicky making this decision include challenges in quickly developing courses for these students who lost out on study abroad due to COVID-19 and through no fault of their own.

<u>P/F Option for S20</u> – Andy Colby and Nicky shared the Faculty Senate's vote to allow a Pass/Fail grading option for S20. Normally, Discovery courses cannot be graded P/F (or Cr/F) but under the current circumstances this will be allowed.

<u>Update on Discovery Program Review</u> – Nicky reported that program review is "a bit stalled," at the moment. The DRC is scheduled to meet on Apr 10, 2020 to discuss how to move forward. The Provost would like review and proposals to move forward but it will be up to the DRC. Nicky will update this committee (DC) on plans regarding program review at the next meeting, Arp 22, 2020.
