She has published in refereed journals such as *The Annals of the American Academy of Political and Social Science*, *Latin American Politics and Society*, *Latin American Research Review*, and *Studies in Comparative International Development*. Diana holds a Ph.D. in Political Science from Vanderbilt University.
