	Approved	Exchange	Managed
Definition	Administered by professional third-party providers or schools abroad.	A reciprocal exchange between select foreign universities to provide students from each school to directly enroll at the partner institution.	Directed and administered by UNH faculty and/or UNH program coordinator.
Academics	Transfer credit guaranteed. Students need pre-approval for filling requirements. Some classes are organized outside of the foreign school's curriculum.	Students directly enroll for courses in the foreign university.	Courses aligned with UNH curricula, making it easy to fulfill UNH Major, Minor and/or Discovery requirements.
Costs and Aid	Pay third party provider directly. Fees included tuition and program fees. Program price includes additional student services, such as accommodation, excursions, and on-site support and coordination. Pay UNH additional administrative fees. Financial aid applies.	Pay UNH tuition and fees. Housing and meals are typically paid while abroad. Financial aid applies.	Pay UNH tuition and fees. Program fees cover housing and may include some meals, excursions, and field trips. Financial aid applies.
Students	Suitable if you would like to study abroad with other American study abroad students, possibly some from UNH. Courses taken with American, international and/or local students.	Suitable if you are independent and would like a full-immersion experience. Courses taken with American, international and/or local students.	Suitable if you would like to study abroad with other UNH students. A few programs also enroll non-UNH students.
When	Offered for academic year, fall, spring, summer, or January term.	Offered academic year, fall, spring, or summer.	Offered fall, spring, summer, or January term. Short term programs tied to UNH courses are offered spring break or in May.
