Our teams have been working diligently to ensure we have a smooth integration plan between the two organizations. In connection with this planning effort, I am announcing some interim changes in our collective organizational structure. These changes are additions or clarifications that will support the continued operations of both GSC and UNH while the planning work continues.

- Scott Stanley, formerly provost and vice president of academic affairs at GSC, will become dean of online education for USNH reporting to UNH Provost Wayne Jones. Scott will support the integration of the GSC and UNH online organizations, along with emerging efforts to expand online across the system.
- As announced earlier, Mike Decelle will continue in his role as dean of UNH Manchester and also become dean of GSC. In his new role, Mike will oversee college operations and directly support the following GSC leaders:

 - Reta Chaffee, director of educational technology
 - Lia Horton, college librarian
- In addition to his current responsibilities, Nicholas Marks will also support Julie Panicci, director of the Child Welfare Education Partnership
- Sam Fucile, director of finance, will now report to UNH CFO Marcel Vernon

Maggie Hyndman, HR director, will now report to UNH CHRO Kathy Neils
